UKSR attends German EU flag forum

In February the Verban Deutscher Reeder (VDR) organised an EU Flag forum in Hamburg and Leer. The event enabled the UK plus a selection of other EU flags to promote their registers to a large German based shipping sector. This sector currently has the need to re-flag a significant percentage of their fleets to EU flags to meet present tonnage tax conditions. At the forums each flag gave a short overview presentation followed by one to one meetings. The UK emphasised its key message of offering a service which delivered 'Quality, Responsiveness and Value for Money' and was well received by industry.
